AN ACT to amend the *Hobart Corporation Acts* 1929-44. [20 December, 1945.] A.D. 1945.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Hobart Corporation Act* Short title. 1945.

Hobart Corporation.

A.D. 1945. **2** The *Hobart Corporation Act 1929* is hereby amended by inserting after section one hundred and fifty-eight F (inserted by the *Hobart Corporation Act 1939*) the following new section one hundred and fifty-eight G:—

“ 158G. It shall be lawful for the Council to appropriate and expend out of the revenues of the Corporation the following sums of money for the respective purposes herein-
after set forth:—

(2) As a contribution to the Victory Regatta 1946, not exceeding	250
