AN ACT to amend the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1929.* [13 November, 1941.] A.D. 1941

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act (No. 2) 1941.* Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

- I. By inserting after the word "Act" in the definition of "Crown land" in section three thereof the words "other than the *Closer Settlement Act 1929.*": Amendment of 20 Geo. V. No. 83. Section 3.

 Section 64.      II. By inserting after subsection (5) of section sixty-four thereof the following new subsection (6)—  
                   “ (6) For the purposes of this Part and Part XI., where any land is subject to the provisions of the *Closer Settlement Act 1929*, the Closer Settlement Board shall be deemed to be the owner of such land.”: and
- Section 78.      III. By expunging subsections (2) and (3) of section seventy-eight thereof and substituting therefor the following new subsection (2)—  
                   “ (2) The cost of every such survey shall be defrayed by the Commission out of its revenues.”.
- Hydro-metric  
 and water  
 power survey.    **3** The Commission shall, as soon as reasonably possible, cause a systematic hydro-metric and water power survey to be carried out in respect of all waters of the State from which it may be reasonably anticipated that power may be obtained in economic quantities, and in respect of any proposed extension scheme or new works shall cause a preliminary design and estimates to be prepared.
