AN ACT to amend the Hobart Corporation Act 1963.

[31 August 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Hobart Corporation Act* Short title and citation.
(No. 2) 1977.

(2) The *Hobart Corporation Act* 1963*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section 228A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of subsection (1) and substituting the following paragraph:—

“(a) after giving at least 5 days’ notice of its intention so to do in a newspaper published in the city, close part of Salamanca Place on any Saturday for not more than 8 hours;”.
