AN ACT to amend the Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1944.

[Royal Assent 11 July 1984]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Hydro-Electric Commission* Short title.
Amendment Act 1984.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives Commence-
the royal assent. ment.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1944** is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 72A of Principal Act (Supply of electrical energy to islands).

4—Section 72A of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

(a) by omitting from subsection (2) (d) “ \$100 ” and substituting “ \$100 000 ”;

(b) by omitting from subsection (2) (e) “ Whenever the ” and substituting “ Subject to subsection (2A), whenever the ”;

(c) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):—

(2A) The provisions of paragraph (e) of subsection (2) do not apply to accounts kept pursuant to paragraph (c) of that subsection in respect of electrical energy supplied to King Island and Flinders Island after 30th June 1984.

(d) by omitting from subsection (4) “ There shall be ” and substituting “ Subject to subsection (5), there shall be ”;

(e) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (4):—

(5) Subsection (4) does not apply to—

(a) any sum paid by the Commission pursuant to subsection (3) in respect of electrical energy supplied to groups of consumers on King Island and Flinders Island; and

(b) the purchase of land or equipment in respect of King Island and Flinders Island for the purposes referred to in that subsection,

after 30th June 1984.
