AN ACT to authorize the expenditure of a sum of money and the application thereof for purposes of the Hydro-Electric Commission, and to amend the Hydro-Electric Commission (Power Development) Act 1967.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Hydro-Electric Commission Short title and (Power Development) Act 1974.

- (2) This Act is incorporated, and shall be read as one, with the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act* 1944.

Installation of generating set.

**2** The installation by the Commission of the equipment as is specified in the Schedule and the carrying out of all work for or necessarily incidental thereto is authorized subject to the provisions of the *Public Account Act* 1957.

Expenses of installation of generating set.

**3** The expenses of and incidental to the work referred to in section 2 shall not exceed \$5 000 000.

Amendment to Hydro-Electric Commission (Power Development) Act 1967.

- **4** The Hydro-Electric Commission (Power Development) Act 1967 is amended—
  - (a) by omitting from section 3 (a) the figures "\$95 000 000"; and substituting therefor the figures "\$151 300 000"; and
  - (b) by omitting from section 3 (c) the figures "\$14 800 000" and substituting therefor the figures "\$17 850 000".

## THE SCHEDULE

(Section 2)

The installation of an additional generating set as part of the power development that in 1957 was referred to in section 5 of, and the First Schedule to, the Loan (Hydro-Electric Commission) Act 1957.
