HEC ENTERPRISES CORPORATION ACT 1995

No. 46 of 1995

AN ACT to provide for the HEC Enterprises Corporation (formerly the Hydro-Electric Commission Enterprises Corporation) to continue and for other purposes

[Royal Assent 22 September 1995]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

PART 1

PRELIMINARY

Short title

1—This Act may be cited as the HEC Enterprises Corporation Act 1995.

Commencement

2—The provisions of this Act commence on a day or days to be proclaimed.

Interpretation

- 3-In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears-
 - "Corporation" means the Hydro-Electric Corporation;
 - "Enterprises Corporation" means the HEC Enterprises Corporation.

PART 2

HEC ENTERPRISES CORPORATION

Continuance of the Enterprises Corporation

4—The Enterprises Corporation, formerly known as the Hydro-Electric Commission Enterprises Corporation, continues.

Functions of the Enterprises Corporation

- 5—The Enterprises Corporation has the following functions:—
 - (a) to provide consultancy services in the electricity supply industry and related industries;
 - (b) to provide project management and project development services in the electricity supply industry and related industries;

- (c) to provide maintenance services in the electricity supply industry and related industries:
- (d) to provide training in the electricity supply industry and related industries.

Corporation may subscribe capital

6—The Corporation may subscribe capital (including loan capital) to the Enterprises Corporation on terms the Corporation considers appropriate.

PART 3

MISCELLANEOUS

Regulations

- 7—(1) The Governor may make regulations for the purposes of this Act.
- (2) Regulations may be made so as to apply differently according to matters, limitations or restrictions, whether as to time, circumstance or otherwise, specified in the regulations.
- (3) The regulations may authorise any matter to be from time to time determined, applied or regulated by the Minister or an officer or person nominated in the regulations.

Administration of Act

- 8—Until provision is made in relation to this Act by order under section 4 of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1990—
 - (a) the administration of this Act is assigned to the Minister for Energy; and
 - (b) the department responsible to the Minister for Energy in relation to the administration of this Act is the Corporation.
