

HOMES (ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR MEMBERS OF THE FORCES).

No. 61 of 1948.

AN ACT to amend the *Homes (Acquisition of Land
for Members of the Forces) Act 1946.*
[15 December, 1948.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Homes (Acquisition of Land for Members of the Forces) Act 1948.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Homes (Acquisition of Land for Members of the Forces) Act 1946**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section twelve of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the words “thirty-first day of December, 1948” and substituting therefor the words “thirtieth day of June, 1949”. Expiry of Act.

3 Notwithstanding the amendment effected by section two of this Act, the Board shall not accept or consider any application under section three of the Principal Act which is received by it after the thirty-first day of December, 1948, or acquire any land, or do any act or thing in connection with the acquisition of any land, under the authority of the Principal Act, in pursuance of any such application received by it after that date. Board not to deal with applications received after 31st December, 1948.
