## **HEALTH REGISTRATION BOARDS (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) ACT 1987**

No. 23 of 1987

AN ACT to amend the Dental Act 1982, Opticians Act 1913, Pharmacy Act 1908, Podiatrists Registration Act 1974, and Radiographers Registration Act 1971.

[Royal Assent 29 April 1987]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, B by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

- 1—This Act may be cited as the *Health Registration Boards* Short title. (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act 1987.
- 2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives commencement. the Royal assent.
  - 3—The Dental Act 1982\* is amended as follows:—

(a) by inserting the following section after section 7:—

7A—Where the Board, any member of the Board, Protection for or the Registrar does, or omits to do, any act or of Board, &c. thing in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported administration or execution

of this Act or in the exercise or performance, or purported exercise or performance, of any of its or his powers, functions, or duties under this Act, the Board, member, or Registrar, as the case may be, shall not be subjected to any action, liability, claim, or demand in respect of that act or omission.

(b) by inserting the following section after section 46:—

Protection for Board, members of Board, &c. 46A—Where the Board, any member of the Board, the Secretary, or any other officer appointed by the Board does, or omits to do, any act or thing in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported administration or execution of this Act or in the exercise or performance, or purported exercise or performance, of any of its or his powers, functions, or duties under this Act, the Board, member, Secretary, or officer, as the case may be, shall not be subjected to any action, liability, claim, or demand in respect of that act or omission.

Amendment of Opticians Act 1913.

4—The Opticians Act 1913† is amended by inserting after section 17 the following section:—

Protection of Board, members of Board, &c. 17A—Where the Board, any member of the Board, the Registrar, or any examiner appointed by the Board does, or omits to do, any act or thing in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported administration or execution of this Act or in the exercise or performance, or purported exercise or performance, of any of its or his powers, functions, or duties under this Act, the Board, member, Registrar, or examiner, as the case may be, shall not be subjected to any action, liability, claim, or demand in respect of that act or omission.

Amendment of Pharmacy Act 1908. 5—The *Pharmacy Act* 1908‡ is amended by inserting the following section after section 11:—

Protection of Board, members of Board, &c. 11A—Where the Board, any member of the Board, the Registrar, or any other officer appointed by the Board does, or omits to do, any act or thing in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported

administration or execution of this Act or in the exercise or performance, or purported exercise or performance, of any of its or his powers, functions, or duties under this Act, the Board, member, Registrar, or officer, as the case may be, shall not be subjected to any action, liability, claim, or demand in respect of that act or omission.

6-The Podiatrists Registration Act 1974§ is amended by Amendment of Podiatrists inserting the following section after section 7:— Registration Act

7A—(1) Where the Board, any member of the Board, Protection of Board, members or any prescribed person does, or omits to do, any act of Board, &c. or thing in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported administration or execution of this Act or in the exercise or performance, or purported exercise or performance, of any of its or his powers, functions, or duties under this Act, the Board, member, or prescribed person, as the case may be, shall not be subjected to any action, liability, claim, or demand in respect of that act or omission.

- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), "prescribed person" means the registrar and secretary of the Board, any officer appointed by the Board, any person made available to the Board under section 6 (3), or any inspector appointed under section 7.
- 7—The Radiographers Registration Act 1971 is amended Amendment of Radiographers by inserting the following section after section 7:—

7A—(1) Where the Board, any member of the Board, Protection of or any prescribed person does, or omits to do, any act of Board, &c. or thing in good faith in the administration or execution, or purported administration or execution of this Act or in the exercise or performance, or purported exercise or performance, of any of its or his powers, functions, or duties under this Act, the Board, member, or prescribed person, as the case may be, shall not be subjected to any action, liability, claim, or demand in respect of that act or omission.
