

II Any other member of the Board, except on the nomination of the body by which that member was nominated or as representing which that member was appointed.

“(3C) Notwithstanding anything in subsection (2) of this section, if a body mentioned in subsection (1) of this section does not, within thirty days after being requested, in writing, by the Minister so to do, nominate a person for appointment as a deputy of a member, the Governor may appoint a person as the deputy of that member without any nomination.

“(3D) A person who is appointed as the deputy of a member of the Board may be paid such fees and allowances as may be determined by the Governor.

“(3E) A person who is appointed as the deputy of a member ceases to hold office as the deputy of that member if the office of that member, for any reason, becomes vacant.”.

4 Section six B of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (1) thereof the words “, and every application for the extension of the classes of dairy produce to which a certificate of registration is limited pursuant to subsection (4) of section six.”.

5 Section six c of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end of subsection (1) the words “either generally or in respect of any specified class or classes of dairy produce”.

AN ACT to amend the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1858, the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1885, the *Mental Deficiency Act* 1920, the *Indeterminate Sentences Act* 1921, the *Psychopathic Hospital (Management) Act* 1933, and the *Nurses' Registration Act* 1952.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Health Services Act* (No. 53 of 1956).

2) 1956.

Interpretation. **2** Section one of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1858 is amended by inserting therein, before the definition of "Hospital", the following definition:—

“ ‘Director’ means the Director of Mental Health: ”.

Superintendent and other officers of hospitals. **3** Section seven of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1858 is amended by omitting therefrom the words “of Mental Hygiene”.

Receiving houses. **4** Section forty-seven of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1858 is amended by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the words “of Mental Hygiene”.

Release of patient on parole in certain cases. **5** Section forty-nine of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1858 is amended by omitting therefrom the words “of Mental Hygiene” (wherever occurring).

6 After section one of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1885 the following section is inserted:—

Interpretation. “2 In this Act, ‘Director’ means the Director of Mental Health.”.

Director of Mental Hygiene to be an official visitor. **7** Section five A of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1885 is amended by omitting therefrom the words “of Mental Hygiene”.

Annual report. **8** Section six A of the *Mental Hospitals Act* 1885 is amended by omitting from subsection (1) thereof the words “of Mental Hygiene”.

Interpretation. **9** Section four of the *Mental Deficiency Act* 1920 is amended by inserting therein, after the definition of “Defective”, the following definition:—

“ ‘Director’ means the Director of Mental Health: ”.

Constitution of Mental Deficiency Board. **10** Section thirty-nine of the *Mental Deficiency Act* 1920 is amended by omitting from paragraph 1 of subsection (2) thereof the words “of Mental Hygiene”.

11 Section three of the *Indeterminate Sentences Act* 1921 is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—

Interpretation. “3 In this Act—

‘Board’ means the Indeterminate Sentences Board constituted under this Act:

‘Director’ means the Director of Mental Health.”.

Constitution of Board. **12** Section twenty-one of the *Indeterminate Sentences Act* 1921 is amended by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the words “of Mental Hygiene”.

13 Section two of the *Psychopathic Hospital (Management) Act 1933* is amended by omitting from the definition of "Director" the word "Hygiene" and substituting therefor the word "Health". Interpretation.

14 Section three of the *Nurses' Registration Act 1952* is amended by inserting therein, after the definition of "Board", the following definition:— Interpretation.

" 'Director' means the Director General of Health Services;".

15 Section four of the *Nurses' Registration Act 1952* is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection (2) the words "Director General of Medical Services" and substituting therefor the word "Director". Constitution of Nurses' Registration Board.

BUILDING.

No. 54 of 1956.

AN ACT to amend the *Building Act 1937*. [29 November 1956.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Building Act 1956*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Building Act 1937*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After section six of the Principal Act the following section is inserted in Part II:—

"6A—(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, a building which does not comply with the requirements of the Building Regulations in respect of its manner of construction may be constructed in accordance with this section. New methods.

(2) The council may approve the construction of a building which does not comply with the requirements of the Building Regulations in respect of its manner of construction if the surveyor certifies—
