## AN ACT to amend the Hobart Stock Exchange Act 1891.

[1 October 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Hobart Stock Exchange Act Short title and 1975.
- (2) The Hobart Stock Exchange Act 1891 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

- 2 Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by omitting the words "twelve members thereof shall be present" and substituting the words "three-fourths of the members thereof are present, either personally or by proxy"; and
- (b) by inserting after the words "transaction of business by members;" the words "for authorizing the appointment of proxies to act on behalf of members at meetings of the Exchange;".
