

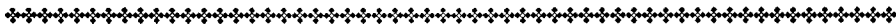


HOBART STOCK EXCHANGE

AN ACT to amend the Hobart Stock Exchange Act 1891.

[1 October 1975]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Hobart Stock Exchange Act* Short title and citation. 1975.

(2) The *Hobart Stock Exchange Act* 1891 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Power to make
rules.

2 Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting the words “ twelve members thereof shall be present ” and substituting the words “ three-fourths of the members thereof are present, either personally or by proxy ”; and
- (b) by inserting after the words “ transaction of business by members;” the words “ for authorizing the appointment of proxies to act on behalf of members at meetings of the Exchange;”.
