

2. Power to Treasurer to borrow £591,200 for purposes of Hydro-Electric Works.

AN ACT to authorise the raising of certain Sums of Money and their Application in defraying the cost of certain Hydro-Electric Works.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Hydro-Electric Works Loan* Short title. Act 1934.

Hydro-Electric Works Loan.

A.D. 1934.

Power to Treasurer to borrow £591,200 for purposes of Hydro-Electric Works. 2 The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Five hundred and ninety-one thousand two hundred Pounds, and apply the same, in accordance with the provisions of the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act* 1929, in defraying the cost of the execution of the works and for the purposes specified in the schedule.
