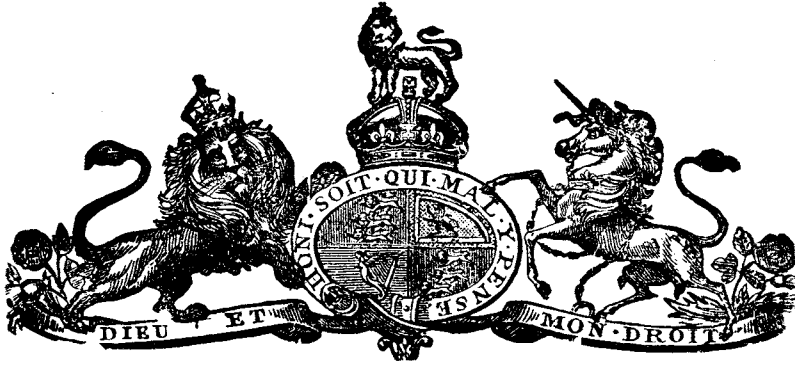

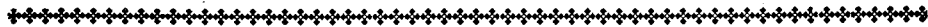

AN ACT to authorise the raising of certain Sums of Money and their Application in defraying the cost of certain Hydro-Electric Works. [27 July, 1934.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Treasurer may raise, borrow, and receive any sum or sums of money, not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of Five hundred and ninety-one thousand two hundred Pounds, and apply the same, in accordance with the provisions of the *Hydro-Electric Commission Act 1929*, in defraying the cost of the execution of the works and for the purposes specified in the schedule.
