AN ACT to amend the Industrial Development Act 1954. [31 October 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Industrial Development* Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Industrial Development Act* 1954, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Powers of Minister.

- **2** Section 8 of the Principal Act is amended—
- (a) by inserting after subsection (4) the following subsections:—
 - "(4A) Without prejudice to the foregoing provisions of this section, the Minister may guarantee the repayment of moneys borrowed or proposed to be borrowed from a bank to facilitate the continued operation in this State of an existing industry.
 - "(4B) No guarantee under subsection (4A) shall be given by the Minister unless the terms and conditions under which the guarantee is given have been approved by the Treasurer."; and
- (b) by omitting paragraph (b) of subsection (7) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—
 - "(b) the Minister shall not guarantee the repayment of any moneys exceeding \$500 000 in the case of any one industry.".
