[15 December, 1948.]**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—**Short title
and citation.****1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Homes (Temporary Housing Accommodation) Act 1948*.(2) The *Homes (Temporary Housing Accommodation) Act 1946** is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.**Power to
borrow
£50,000.****2** Section two of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the word “fifty” and substituting therefor the word “seventy-five”.

INDUSTRIES ESTABLISHMENT.

No. 47 of 1948.**AN ACT** to amend the *Industries Establishment Act 1946*.
[15 December, 1948.]**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—**Short title
and citation.****1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Industries Establishment Act 1948*.(2) The *Industries Establishment Act 1946**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 After section six of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

“6A.—(1) For the purposes of this Act there shall be an advisory committee (in this Act referred to as “the committee”), which shall consist of three persons appointed by the Governor. Advisory committee.

(2) One of the members of the committee shall be the Director of Industrial Development, who shall be the chairman of the committee.

(3) The committee shall meet at such times as the chairman may consider necessary and at such other times as the Minister may direct.

(4) The committee may regulate its own procedure.

(5) The committee shall consider and report upon such matters with respect to the administration of this Act as may be referred to it by the Minister or the Director of Industrial Development for consideration and report.”.

3 Section seven of the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following subsection:— Expenditure on recommendation of Director.

“(2) No recommendation under this section with respect to the expenditure of any moneys shall be made by the Director of Industrial Development unless he has first submitted the question of such expenditure to the committee for consideration and report.”.

4 Section nine of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) the numerals “£200,000” and substituting therefor the numerals “£500,000”. Provision for loans and other purposes.

5 The schedule to the Principal Act is amended by adding at the end thereof the following item:— Schedule.

“No. 5 of 1948	Public Works Execution Act 1948	Schedule, Part II. Item 4	100,000.”.
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6 The Director of Industrial Development shall in the month of August in each year prepare and transmit to the Minister a report of the operations of the Committee during the preceding year and a copy of such report shall be laid before each House of Parliament within fifteen sitting days after its receipt by the Minister. Annual report.

7 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the numerals “1949” and substituting therefor the numerals “1950”. No agreement to be made after 30th June, 1949.
