AN ACT to amend the *Inspection of Machinery Act 1902.* [16 November, 1942.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Inspection of Machinery Act 1942.* Short title.

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—Amendment

Section 11.

I. By deleting the words “a male” in paragraph II. of section eleven thereof and substituting “any person”; and deleting the words “or a female”:

Section 24.

II. As to section twenty-four thereof by deleting the words—

(a) “any female or”; and

(b) “or working” in subsection (3) and inserting “or” before “management”:

Section 56.

III. As to section fifty-six thereof—

(a) By deleting the words “Commissioner of Taxes” in—

(i) Subsection (1): and

(ii) Subsection (2)—

respectively and substituting therefor the words “Chief Inspector of Factories”: and

(b) By deleting the words “and thereupon” to “thereunder” at the end of subsection (2):

Section 58.

IV. As to section fifty-eight thereof by inserting—

(a) “(1)” at the commencement: and

(b) “(2) The regulations may provide for and prescribe the steps that shall be taken and the safeguards that shall be provided for the protection of persons using, or working in the vicinity of, any specified class of machinery; and the persons by whom the same shall be taken, provided, and maintained as prescribed.”. (at the end): and

V. By expunging the proviso to the first item in the fifth schedule hereto.
