32B—Power of Minister to intervene, &c.

AN ACT to amend the Industrial Relations Act 1975 for the purpose of providing the Minister for the time being administering that Act with a right to intervene in proceedings before an industrial board or the chairman of Industrial Boards.

[Royal Assent 16 February 1983]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Industrial Relations Amendment* Short title. Act (No. 2) 1983.

Commencement. No. 4

**2**—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent.

Insertion of new section 32B in Industrial Relations Act 1975. **3**—After section 32A of the *Industrial Relations Act* 1975\*, the following section is inserted:—

Power of Minister to intervene, &c.

- 32B—After giving notice in writing of his intention to intervene to the chairman, the Minister may—
  - (a) on behalf of the State of Tasmania, intervene in the public interest in a matter before a board or the chairman; and
  - (b) make submissions, either in person or by his agent, to that board or the chairman in relation to that matter.
