32B—Power of Minister to intervene, &c.



AN ACT to amend the Industrial Relations Act 1975 for the purpose of providing the Minister for the time being administering that Act with a right to intervene in proceedings before an industrial board or the chairman of Industrial Boards.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Industrial Relations Amendment Act (No. 2) 1983*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent.

3—After section 32A of the *Industrial Relations Act 1975**, the following section is inserted:—

Power of
Minister to
intervene, &c.

32B—After giving notice in writing of his intention to intervene to the chairman, the Minister may—

- (a) on behalf of the State of Tasmania, intervene in the public interest in a matter before a board or the chairman; and
- (b) make submissions, either in person or by his agent, to that board or the chairman in relation to that matter.
