AN ACT to amend the Industrial Safety, Health, and Welfare Act 1977 for the purpose of providing certain protection to officers engaged for the purposes of that Act and for related purposes.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the Industrial Safety, Health, and Short title. Welfare Amendment Act 1981.

Industrial Safety, Health, and Welfare Amendment

Substitution of section 15 of Industrial Safety, Health, and Welfare Act 1977. **2**—Section 15 of the *Industrial Safety, Health, and Welfare Act* 1977* is repealed and the following section is substituted:—

Protection from liability.

- 15—(1) Subject to subsection (2), any matter or thing done, or omitted to be done, in good faith by an authorized officer for the purpose or purported purpose of the exercise by him of the powers conferred on him by this Act shall not subject him personally to any action, liability, claim or demand.
- (2) Subsection (1) does not preclude the Crown from being subject to any action, liability, claim, or demand to which the Crown would, but for that subsection, have been subject.
