- I. “(1)” at the commencement: and
- II. “(2) If the parents of the child are living apart and the spouse, other than the applicant, satisfies the court that he or she is able and willing to control the child, and that such control will not be prejudicial to the welfare of the child, the court may make an order transferring the custody of the child to such other spouse, and thereupon no order shall be made under subsection (1) hereof while the order as made remains in force.”
