AN ACT to amend the Justices Act 1959.

[Royal Assent 27 June 1984]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Justices Amendment Act 1984*. Short title.

2—This Act shall commence on the day on which it receives the royal assent. Commence-
ment.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Justices Act 1959** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4—(1) Section 34 (1) of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) “ police; or ” and substituting “ police;”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) “ station,” and substituting “ station; or ”;
- (c) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (b):—
 - (ba) in the case of an offence against the *Road Safety (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1970*, an approved operator within the meaning of section 3 (6) of that Act,
- (d) by omitting from paragraph (d) “ or other police officer ” and substituting “ , other police officer, or approved operator ”.

(2) Section 34 (3) of the Principal Act is amended by omitting “ or other police officer ” and substituting “ , other police officer, or approved operator ”.
