

3—(1) Notwithstanding anything in the Principal Act, the Trust is authorized to pay, out of the moneys at the disposal of the Trust for the purposes of that Act, to the Operator the sum of £6,440 by way of compensation to the Operator for ceasing to carry on the services mentioned in the preamble to this Act. Payment of compensation.

(2) The sum mentioned in subsection (1) of this section shall be paid to the Operator by the Trust within fourteen days after the commencement of this Act.

AN ACT to amend the *Judges' Salaries Act 1920*.
[26 June 1958.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Judges' Salaries Act* 1958. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Judges' Salaries Act 1920*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2 Section two of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) the words “four thousand” and substituting therefor the words “four thousand five hundred”; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) the words “three thousand five hundred” and substituting therefor the words “four thousand”.
