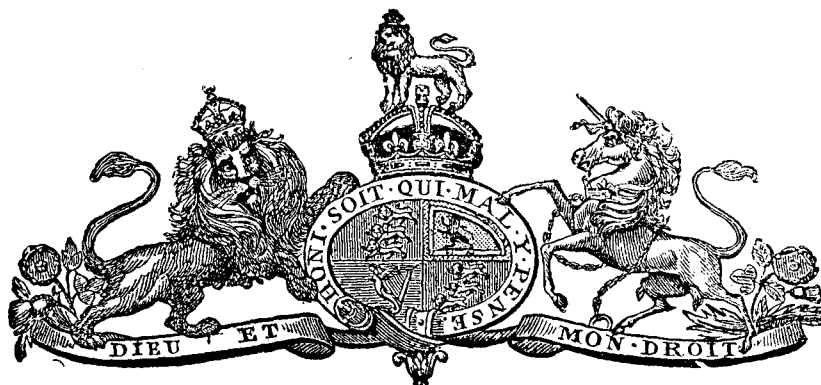

AN ACT to amend the *Licensing Act 1932*.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act 1935*.
- 2 The Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (3) of section thirty-six thereof the following new subsection (4) :—
“(4) Where the premises to which the application relates are distant more than twenty miles from the place where the nearest health officer resides, the court may accept the certificate of an inspector as to the matters required by subsection (1) hereof, to be certified by a health officer.”
