AN ACT to amend the *Licensing Act* 1932.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Licensing Act* 1937.

2 So much of the *Licensing Act* 1933, as is not already repealed, is hereby repealed.

3 Any person, who, in pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (4) of section fifty-six of the Principal Act (as inserted by proclamation gazetted on the eighth day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six), gave notice of appeal against any order, decision, or determination of a court under that Act, may, within twenty-one days after the passing of this Act, again give notice of such appeal, and commence his appeal *de novo*, and may have the same heard and determined upon the merits.
