AN ACT to amend the *Libraries Act 1943*.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Libraries Act 1944*. Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Libraries Act 1943*\* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

*Libraries.*

A.D. 1944. **2**—(1) Section nineteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting therefor the following subsection—  
 State aid.

“(2) A council shall become eligible for State aid under this section if the Board is satisfied that the council is expending moneys, out of the proceeds of any rates, levied by the council upon the provision, control, and management within its district of libraries or library services under this Act at such a rate as will, in the opinion of the Board, amount to not less than the prescribed amount during any period of twelve months.”.

(2) Subsection (1) shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date of the commencement of the Principal Act.

**3** Subsection (8) of section twenty-four of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after the word “print” the words “gramophone record, film,”.
