AN ACT to amend the Licensing Act 1932 with respect to the fees to be paid thereunder.

[14 October 1974]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Licensing (Fees) Act 1974*. Short title, citation, and commencement.
- (2) The *Licensing Act 1932*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) This Act shall commence on 1st July 1975.

2 Section 24 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (1A) the words “ six per cent ” and substituting therefor “ 8 per cent ”;
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1B) the words “ six per cent ” and substituting therefor “ 8 per cent ”; and
- (c) by omitting from subsection (5) the words “ six per cent ” and substituting therefor “ 8 per cent ”.

3 Section 79 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (2) the words “ six per cent ” and substituting therefor “ 8 per cent ”; and
- (b) by omitting from subsection (3) the words “ six per cent ” and substituting therefor “ 8 per cent ”.
