**AN ACT to amend the Limitation Act 1974.**

[18 May 1978]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Limitation Act 1978*.

(2) The *Limitation Act 1974*\* is in this Act referred to as the **Principal Act**.

**2** After section 16 of the Principal Act the following section is inserted:—

“ 16A Where a right of action has accrued to any person that action cannot be brought by that person or his successors in title against any person who has *bona fide* purchased a legal estate in land for value without notice of the circumstances which gave rise to the accruer of the right of action.”.
