**AN ACT to amend the Legal Assistance Act 1962.**

**[24 January 1975]**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—**(1) This Act may be cited as the *Legal Assistance Act 1974*. Short title and citation.
- (2) The *Legal Assistance Act 1962*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**Interpretation.**

**2** Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting at the end of the definition of "assisted person" the words "or by an officer of the Australian Legal Aid Office".

**Exemption  
from fees.**

**3** Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting in subsection (5), at the end of the definition of "authorized officer", the words "or the Deputy Director in this State of the Australian Legal Aid Office or some person authorized by him in that behalf".
