AN ACT to amend the Litter Act 1973 for the purpose of extending

AN ACT to amend the Litter Act 1973 for the purpose of extending the application of the Act in certain cases to land in respect of which a charge for admission is made, and for incidental purposes.

[Royal Assent 26 November 1980]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Litter Amendment Act 1980. Short title.
- 2—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date commence of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such date as may be fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the *Litter Act* 1973* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 3 of Principal Act (Authorized officers).

- **4**—Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (3):—
 - (4) The duties and powers of an authorized officer under this Act may be performed or exercised in respect of land declared under section 4 (3) to be subject to this Act only by a person who is such an officer by virtue of his having been appointed under subsection (2) of this section.

Amendment of section 4 of Principal Act (Offences).

- 5—Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:—
 - (a) by inserting at the end of paragraph (i) of subsection (1) "and that land is not at that time declared under subsection (3) to be land that is subject to this Act";
 - (b) by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):—
 - (3) A municipality, in whose district there is land in respect of which a charge for admission is to be made, may, by public notification, published in such manner as may be prescribed, declare that land to be subject to this Act for the duration of the period in respect of which that charge for admission is made, and any notification so published shall have effect accordingly.
