AN ACT to amend the Liquor and Accommodation Act 1990 [Royal Assent 17 March 1994]

 \mathbf{B}^{E} it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title

1994

1—This Act may be cited as the Liquor and Accommodation Amendment Act 1994.

Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Liquor and Accommodation Act 1990* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Section 65 amended (Licensee to restrict people on certain licensed premises outside authorized hours)

4-Section 65 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:-

- (a) by inserting in subsection (1) "or an on-licence" after "general licence";
- (b) by omitting from subsection (1) (b) "permit—or at any time on a Good Friday," and substituting "permit; and";
- (c) by inserting the following paragraphs after paragraph (b) of subsection (1):--
 - (c) midnight on the Thursday before Good Friday and 11 a.m. on Good Friday; and
 - (d) 9 p.m. on Good Friday and 5 a.m. on the Saturday after Good Friday.
