# AN ACT to amend the Legal Aid Commission Act 1990 [Royal Assent 25 August 1994]

B<sup>E</sup> it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows: -

#### Short title

1-This Act may be cited as the Legal Aid Commission Amendment Act 1994.

#### Commencement

2—This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

## Principal Act

3—In this Act, the Legal Aid Commission Act 1990\* is referred to as the Principal Act.

## Section 7 amended (Powers of Commission)

- 4—Section 7 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after subsection (2) the following subsection:—
  - (3) This section does not empower the Commission to appoint any person as an employee or officer.

# Section 10 amended (Staff of Commission)

- 5—Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting "may, at the request of, and with the agreement of, the Commission, provide it with employees employed in the Department" and substituting "may—
  - (a) appoint a person subject to and in accordance with the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984; and
  - (b) at the request of, and with the agreement of, the Commission, provide it with employees employed in the Department".

## Validation of appointments

6—A person purported to have been appointed under section 7 of the Principal Act by the Commission is taken to have been appointed under section 10 of that Act subject to and in accordance with the Tasmanian State Service Act 1984.
