AN ACT to authorise the Funding of the Deficit in the Consolidated Revenue Fund for the financial year ended the thirtieth day of June, 1948.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the Consolidated Revenue Deficit (Funding) Act 1950.

Power to borrow £23,907 16s. 11d. to fund d ficit for 1947-48.

2 The Treasurer may borrow any sums of money, not exceeding £23,907 16s. 11d., for the purpose of funding the deficit in the Consolidated Revenue for the financial year ended on the thirtieth day of June, 1948.

LANDLORD AND TENANT.

No. 20 of 1950.

AN ACT to amend the Landlord and Tenant Act 1949. [30 June, 1950.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Landlord and Tenant Act 1950.
- (2) The Landlord and Tenant Act 1949* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Expiry of Act.

- 2—(1) Section eighty-eight of the Principal Act is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor:—
- "88. This Act shall expire on the thirty-first day of October, 1950."
- (2) This section shall be deemed to have commenced on the twenty-ninth day of June, 1950.
