3 The amount so borrowed shall be used to reimburse the Use of moneys Council for the loss incurred by the Council in the execution of certain works under the provisions of the New Norfolk Sewerage  $Act 1941 \ddagger$ .

4 The moneys secured by the said debentures shall be Security and made payable over a period of twenty-five years from the date of issue and such payments of principal and interest moneys shall be charged upon and paid out of the sewerage rate authorized to be levied by section five of the New Norfolk Sewerage Act 1941‡.

Short title and commencement.

- **1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Salaries and Allowances Act 1948.
- (2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the 21st day of August, 1948.

Salaries of Ministers.

- 2 Section eight of the Ministers of the Crown Act 1923\* is amended by omitting paragraph II. of subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following paragraph:
  - "II. To the person for the time being holding the office of Premier-
