BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as the *Launceston Corporation Act 1937.* Short title.

A.D. 1937. **2** *The Launceston Corporation Act (No. 3) 1924* is hereby amended by deleting “Vernon-street” in the seventeenth line of the schedule thereto and substituting “Bailey-street”, and by inserting after that item the following new items—

“Cridge-street, Walter-street, Bell-street, and Bailey-street respectively

From Hobart-road to Leslie-street

Collins-street from Bell-street to Vernon-street”.
