- (b) by inserting in paragraph III of that sub-rule, after the word "incapacity", the words "not being a payment, allowance, or benefit paid in respect of a period of long service leave or of any entitlement thereto or in lieu of the taking of a period of long service leave": and

Workers' Compensation.

(c) by omitting from sub-rule (6) of that rule the words "two thousand three hundred and forty" and substituting therefor the words "four thousand".

# LOAN FUND APPROPRIATION.

### No. 17 of 1960.

AN ACT to authorize the issue and application of moneys from the Loan Fund, and to provide for [20 June 1960.] matters incidental thereto.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:-

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the Loan Fund Appropriation  $Ac\bar{t}$  1960.

Interpretation.

- 2 In this Act, unless the contrary intention appears—
  - "Financial Agreement" means the agreement made between the Commonwealth and the States and ratified by the Financial Agreement Act 1927, and includes that agreement as varied from time to time and any agreement made in substitution therefor:
  - "Loan Fund" means the Loan Fund established under section six of the Public Account Act 1957.

Appropriation of Loan Fund.

3—(1) For the purposes of this Act, the Treasurer may issue out of the Loan Fund (which, to the necessary extent, is appropriated accordingly) the sum of £5,022,150.

- (2) Of the sum issued out of the Loan Fund under the authority of this section—
  - (a) the sum of £4,773,700 may be applied for the several public works or purposes that are specified in the first schedule;
  - (b) the sum of £74,500 may be applied in accordance with the provisions of the Transport Act 1938, by way of capital expenditure in connection with the transport undertaking, for the works and purposes that are specified in the second schedule:

(c) the sum of £131,950 may be applied in accordance with the provisions of the *Metropolitan Transport Act* 1954 by way of capital expenditure in connection with the works and purposes that are specified in the third schedule; and

(d) the sum of £42,000 may be applied in accordance with the provisions of the Water Act 1957 by way of capital expenditure in connection with the works and purposes that are specified in the fourth schedule.

- **4** For the purposes of this Act, the Treasurer may arrange Power of for the borrowing on behalf of the State, in accordance with to borrow the Financial Agreement, of any sums of money not exceeding moneys. £5,022,150.
- 5—(1) The public works and purposes that are specified Authority for carrying in the first schedule may be executed and carried out by the out of works Minister administering the Act or Department under or for and purposes. the purposes of which those works and purposes are respectively required to be executed and carried out.
- (2) The sum to be expended pursuant to this Act for any work or purpose that is specified in the first schedule shall not exceed the sum set forth in that schedule in respect of that work or purpose.
