

LOAN FUND APPROPRIATION 1963-1964.

No. 52 of 1963.

AN ACT to authorize the issue and application of moneys from the Loan Fund for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1964, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.
[24 October 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Loan Fund Appropriation Act 1963-1964*.

(2) This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of July 1963.

Issue and application of moneys from the Loan Fund.

2—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan Fund the sum of £14,217,500.

(2) The sum issued out of the Loan Fund under the authority of this section, together with the sums issued thereout under the authority of section seven D of the *Public Account Act 1957* for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1964 (amounting as appears by the first schedule to the sum of £18,088,000), are appropriated for, and shall be applied for, the works and purposes that are specified in the second schedule.

Power to borrow moneys.

3 The Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing on behalf of the State, in accordance with the Financial Agreement, of the sum of £16,010,000.

Ratification of certain expenditure.

4—(1) The issue and application, pursuant to subsection (1) of section seven A of the *Public Account Act 1957*, of the sums of money specified in the third schedule for the purposes therein specified are ratified.

(2) The issue and application, pursuant to section seven B of the *Public Account Act 1957*, of the sums of money specified in the fourth schedule for the purposes therein specified are ratified.

5 The borrowing on behalf of the State, in accordance with the Financial Agreement, during the financial year that ended on the thirtieth day of June 1963 of the sum of £15,354,000 (being £252,000 in excess of the sum authorized by section three of the *Loan Fund Appropriation Act 1962-1963* to be borrowed on behalf of the State) is ratified, and shall be deemed for all purposes to have been authorized by that section. DAIRY PRODUCTS MARKETING.

No. 53 of 1963.

AN ACT to amend the *Dairy Products Marketing Act 1957*. [24 October 1963.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title
and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Dairy Products Marketing Act 1963*.

(2) The *Dairy Products Marketing Act 1957* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Application
of quota.

2 Section ten of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by inserting in subsection (4), after the word “convicted”, the words “of an offence”; and
- (b) by omitting from that subsection the words “he has” and substituting therefor the words “, before complaint was made for that offence, he had”.
