AN ACT to authorize the issue and application of money from the Loan Fund for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1983 and for incidental matters.

[Royal Assent 28 October 1982]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Loan Fund Appropriation Act* Short title. 1982-1983.

Commence-
ment.

2—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st July 1982.

Issue and

3—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan Fund for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1983 sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate \$99,959,949 in addition to money he is authorized to issue by the *Loan Fund Supply Act* 1982-1983.

(2) The sums authorized to be issued out of the Loan Fund by this Act and by the *Loan Fund Supply Act* 1982-1983 for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1983, amounting as appears by Schedule 1 to \$141,959,949, are appropriated for and shall be applied for the works and purposes specified in Schedule 2.

Borrowing

4—The Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing of \$64,151,000 on behalf of the State in accordance with the Financial Agreement.

5—The issue and application, pursuant to sections 7A and 7B of the *Public Account Act* 1957, of the sums of money specified in Schedule 3, for the purposes specified in that Schedule, are ratified.
