AN ACT to authorize the issue and application of money from the Loan Fund for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1986 and for incidental matters.

[Royal Assent 1 November 1985]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—This Act may be cited as the *Loan Fund Appropriation Act* Short title.

2—This Act shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st July 1985.

Issue and

3—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan Fund for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1986 sums of money not exceeding in the aggregate \$129,615,000 in addition to money he is authorized to issue by the *Loan Fund Supply Act* 1985-1986.

(2) The sums authorized to be issued out of the Loan Fund by this Act and by the *Loan Fund Supply Act* 1985-1986 for the service of the year ending on 30th June 1986, amounting as appears by Schedule 1 to \$169,615,000, are appropriated for and shall be applied for the works and purposes specified in Schedule 2.

4—The Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing of \$70,541,000 on behalf of the State in accordance with the Financial Agreement, and such other sums as may be required for the purposes of the State.

5—The issue and application, pursuant to section 7A of the *Public Account Act* 1957, of the sums of money specified in Schedule 3, for the purposes specified in that Schedule, are ratified.
