AN ACT to validate the Payment by the Fire Brigade Board for the District of Launceston of Retiring Allowances to Keith Rowland Ritchie, formerly Secretary of the Board, and the late Charles George Croft, formerly Superintendent of the Launceston Fire Brigade. [17 June, 1941.]

- 2 The payment by the Fire Brigade Board for the District of Launceston (whether before or after the commencement of this Act) of a retiring allowance amounting to—
 - I. One hundred and fifty pounds to Keith Rowland Ritchie, formerly Secretary of the Board: and
 - II. Two hundred and fifty pounds to the late Charles George Croft, formerly Superintendent of the Launceston Fire Brigade, or his personal representative—

respectively, by equal quarterly instalments, is hereby validated, and those allowances and all payments on account thereof shall be deemed to be, and to have been, lawfully and validly made.
