FRUIT BOARD.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Fruit Board Act 1962.
- (2) The Fruit Board Act 1934, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Expenses of Board.

- 2 Section six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (1) and substituting therefor the following subsection:—
- "(1) The Board may pay out of its funds to a member of the Board such fee as the Governor may determine for each day on which that member attends a meeting of the Board and, in respect of the attendance of that member at meetings of the Board or of his engaging on any business authorized by the Board, such travelling or other allowances as may be prescribed.".

Application of funds of Board.

- 3 Section eighteen of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (5) and substituting therefor the following subsections:—
- "(5) Subject to subsection (6) of this section, the Board may, for any purposes connected with the exercise of its functions, expend out of its funds such sums as it thinks proper.
