LOAN FUND SUPPLY 1968-1969.

No. 9 of 1968.

AN ACT to apply out of the Loan Fund a sum for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June 1969. [1 July 1968.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as the Loan Fund Supply Act Short title. 1968-1969.
- 2—(1) The Treasurer may issue out of the Loan Fund Issue and for the service of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June \$15,000,000. 1969, sums of money not exceeding in the whole \$15,000,000 for any purpose that—
 - (a) is specified in the first schedule to the Loan Fund Appropriation Act 1967-1968; or
 - (b) should, in the opinion of the Governor, be carried out in the public interest and is recommended by the Treasurer as properly to be paid for out of the Loan Fund.
- (2) The application of each sum for the purposes of this section shall be determined by the Governor without any authority other than this section.
- 3 The Treasurer may arrange for the borrowing on behalf Power to of the State, in accordance with the Financial Agreement, of moneys. such sums as are required for the purposes of this Act.
- 4 The Treasurer shall incorporate all moneys issued and Expenditure applied, or to be issued and applied, under this Act in the Act to be estimates of expenditure from the Loan Fund to be submitted into Parliament for the year ending on the thirtieth day of June Fund 1969 as if their issue and application were to be authorized Appropriation afresh by the ordinary Loan Fund Appropriation Act for that year.
