2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By inserting at the end of subsection (3) of section one hundred and fifteen thereof the words “or in case of a cemetery so taken over may appoint any person to act on such committee”: and

II. By inserting after paragraph VI. of subsection (1) of section one hundred and seventy-three thereof the following new paragraph VII.—

“VII. Property belonging to any city or municipal council and occupied or used by such council for any public utility.”

3 During the continuation of the war in which His Majesty is at present engaged any council may set aside any unexpended balance of the amount received by it by way of road rates in respect of any financial year as a reserve for future requirements in relation to the purposes for which such rates were levied, and may apply any amount for such purposes as and when occasion may arise.

4—(1) Every council which holds any sum comprising moneys collected by it by way of tax under any Act repealed by the *Fruit Board Act* 1934, shall pay such sum to the State Fruit Board forthwith.

(2) All amounts received by the said Board under this section shall be applied for the purposes of the *Fruit Board Act* 1934.
