AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act 1962.

[28 April 1977]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government Act 1977*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Local Government Act 1962**, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

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2 Section 734 of the Principal Act is amended—

- (a) by omitting from subsection (6) “ Interim Planning Appeal Board constituted under subsection (19)” and substituting “ Planning Appeal Board ”;
- (b) by omitting from subsections (9) and (11) “ of petty sessions for the municipality ” (wherever occurring) and substituting “ to the Commissioner ” in each case;
- (c) by omitting from subsections (12), (13), (15), and (20) “ Board ” (wherever occurring) and substituting “ Planning Appeal Board ” in each case; and
- (d) by omitting subsection (19) and substituting the following subsection:—

“(19) The Planning Appeal Board shall consist of—

- (a) a legal practitioner or barrister, who shall be the chairman;
and
- (b) two persons, at least one of whom shall be experienced in town and country planning,

appointed by the Governor for such term as the Governor may determine.”.
