**AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act 1962 in relation to the entitlement of certain electors to vote at municipal elections, to amend the Hobart Corporation Act 1977 and the Launceston Corporation Act 1977 in relation to the payment of interest on overdue rates, and to remove from the Launceston Corporation Act 1963 the provision relating to the limit on rates.**

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (Miscellaneous) Act 1977*.

(2) Sections 3 and 4 shall be deemed to have commenced on 19th May 1977.

**2** Section 77 of the *Local Government Act 1962* is amended by omitting from subsection (4) (a) the words “ occupier-elect or ”.

**3** Section 17 of the *Hobart Corporation Act 1977* is amended by omitting subsection (2).

Amendment of  
the *Launceston  
Corporation  
Act 1977.*

**4** Section 10 of the *Launceston Corporation Act 1977* is amended by omitting subsection (2) and substituting the following subsection:—

“(2) This section applies to any interest charged after 30th June 1977 in respect of any unpaid rate or any part or instalment of a rate, whether payable before, on, or after that date.”.

**5** Section 91 of the *Launceston Corporation Act 1963* is repealed.
