

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT (No. 2).

No. 84 of 1954.

AN ACT to amend the *Local Government Act 1906*.  
[21 December, 1954.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania,  
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative  
Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,  
as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government Act (No. 2) 1954*. Short title and citation.

(2) The *Local Government Act 1906*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

**2** Section one hundred and sixty-six of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (1) the words "one shilling and threepence" and substituting therefor the words "sixpence". Minimum road rate to be levied at least once a year: Application of proceeds.

## STATE EMPLOYEES (LONG-SERVICE LEAVE).

AN ACT to amend the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1950*, and to provide for the payment of allowances in lieu of long-service leave to certain persons employed by the State for the purposes of the *Prices Act 1948*.

Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled,  
as follows:—

**1**—(1) This Act may be cited as the *State Employees (Long-Service Leave) Act 1954*. Short title and citation.
