718B—Special Commissioners for Town and Country Planning.

AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act 1962 for the purpose of making provision for the appointment of Special Commissioners for Town and Country Planning.

[Royal Assent 28 November 1979]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2—After section 718A of the *Local Government Act 1962**, the following section is inserted:—

718B—(1) The Governor may, from time to time if he considers it necessary and desirable to do so, appoint a Special Commissioner for Town and Country Planning (in this section referred to as a “Special Commissioner”) to exercise such of the powers and perform such of the functions of the Commissioner in relation to a particular matter arising under this Part as are specified in the Special Commissioner’s instrument of appointment.

(2) The instrument of appointment of a Special Commissioner shall provide that the powers and functions of the Commissioner that are vested by the instrument in the Special Commissioner may be exercised and performed by him only in relation to the matter arising under this Part that is, and in the circumstances that are, specified in the instrument.

(3) A Special Commissioner shall be a person of special ability and experience in town and country planning.

(4) A Special Commissioner—

(a) holds office on such terms and conditions as are specified in his instrument of appointment; and

(b) is entitled to be paid such fees and allowances as the Governor approves.
