3-After section 862 of the Local Government Act 1962*, the following section is inserted:-

Power to deal with property

862AA—Notwithstanding anything contained in this Part, the Association may, either alone or in common with another person or body, purchase, exchange, take on lease, dispose of by lease or sale and otherwise deal with property, both real and personal.
