AN ACT to amend the Local Government Act 1962.

[Royal Assent 27 November 1987]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1—This Act may be cited as the Local Government Short title. Amendment (General Fire Regulations Appeal) Act 1987.
- 2—(1) This section and section 1 shall commence on the Commencement. day on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (1), this Act shall commence on such day as may be fixed by proclamation.

Principal Act.

3—In this Act, the Local Government Act 1962* is referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of section 461k of Principal Act (Jurisdiction).

- 4—Section 461K of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):—
 - (2A) A person aggrieved by a requirement in any provisions of the *General Fire Regulations 1975* relating to existing premises may appeal to the Board.
