BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Principal Act is hereby amended—

Section 3.

I. By inserting after "Act" in the penultimate line of section three thereof the words "and the premises at which he carries on such business are so registered.":

Section 4.

II. As to section four thereof—

(a) By inserting at the end of subsection (1) the words "and the premises at which such person carries on such business":

(b) By inserting "or premises" after "person" in the first line of subsection (4): and

(c) By inserting after that subsection the following new subsection (5):—

"(5) Where any such person carries on business at more places than one, all the premises at which he carries on such business shall be separately registered": and

Section 8.

III. By deleting the words "unless" to "Act" in the eighth line of section eight thereof.
