LAUNCESTON MARINE BOARD LOAN.

No. 3 of 1960.

AN ACT to amend the *Launceston Marine Board Loan Act 1951.* [20 June 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Launceston Marine Board Loan Act 1960.* Short title and citation.

(2) The *Launceston Marine Board Loan Act 1951* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Borrowing powers.

2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the numerals "500,000" and substituting therefor the numerals "1,500,000".

TASMANIAN ORCHESTRA (CONTINUATION).

No. 4 of 1960.

AN ACT to amend the *Tasmanian Orchestra (Continuation) Act 1951*. [20 June 1960.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

1—(1) This Act may be cited as the *Tasmanian Orchestra (Continuation) Act 1960*.

(2) The *Tasmanian Orchestra (Continuation) Act 1951*, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

State contribution.

2 Section three of the Principal Act is amended by omitting therefrom the numerals "1960" and substituting therefor the numerals "1963".
